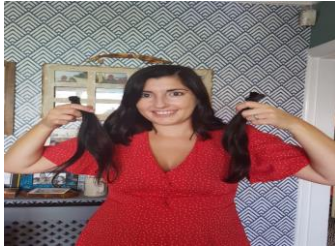
Well done to Class 6 who have secured £5.00 into their Class Bank this week!
